During the workshop we will discuss that safety culture and safety in general are not separate concepts, attributes or characteristics of a business but an integral part of it we will also discuss that improving safety culture improves efficiency and job effectiveness in general and vice versa. MANAGEMENT FORCE has developed and implemented the Involvement for Continuous Safety Improvement (ICSI) method, which aims at improving a company's human resources safety culture and therefore improving the safety culture of the company itself as a whole.

The workshop will use the experiences of ICSI as well as the participants' experiences, discuss and synthesise them in order to highlight both the importance of changing the safety culture and the best ways to achieve this change while recognising and discussing difficulties, problems and challenges.

During the workshop we will discuss the Project Life Cycle Safety approach as key element of a successful project risk management program. A proper lifecycle management system ensures that adequate planning and procedures exists that make certain that the safety system shall meet the safety requirements. It demonstrates by review, analysis and/or testing that the required outputs satisfy the defined requirements for the appropriate phases of the safety life cycle identified by the verification planning.
