
28 April 2023: World Day for Safety and Health at Work

 - ✓ This year's focus: A safe and healthy working environment is a fundamental principle and right at work




The International Labour Conference (ILC) decided to include "a safe and healthy working environment" in the ILO's framework of fundamental principles and rights at work.

this occasion, On Occupational the Safety Health and Convention, No. **155** and Promotional the Framework for Occupational Safety Health and No. Convention, 187 were declared fundamental conventions.

All Member states, even if they have not ratified the Conventions in question, have an obligation, arising from the very fact of membership the in Organization, to respect, to promote and to realize, in good faith and accordance with the Constitution, the principles concerning the fundamental rights which are the subject of those Conventions.

- ❖ Fundamental conventions Nos 155 and 187, are fully complementary and reflect the relevant principles, duties and rights for ensuring a safe and healthy working environment.
- They contain provisions of general scope covering all branches of activity and all workers, regardless of the type of hazard, and they serve as the basis for the safety and health measures provided in other specific OSH instruments.
- ❖ In order to fully meet the requirements of Conventions Nos 155 and 187, Members need to take into account the provisions of the full body of OSH instruments set out in the chart
